Vision


Everyone, regardless of age, ability and circumstance of life shall be able to feel secure in an active life outside the home







Fills a gap in social services










Main functions

Relatives follow position when unsafe

Alarm to the monitoring station, they search available volunteers who can support on the spot




or alert to relatives/followers directly
