





Old-age dependency ratios


Number of people aged 65 and over As % of labour force (aged 15-64), forecasts






WHERE IS THE HEALTH TECHNOLOGY MARKET HEADED?



ASSISTIVE SERVICE TECHNOLOGIES - FALLS



Falls

- Major Public Health Issue
- Combination of Physical, Behavioral and environmental
- 1/3 65 and over fall each year > 10-20% have injuries which reduce mobility





ASSISTIVE SERVICES TECHNOLOGIES – COGNITIVE DECLINE



14% of people over 70 are diagnosed with Dementia (37% age 90 and older)





ASSISTIVE SERVICES TECHNOLOGIES – SENSORY DEFICITS



Sensory Impairments

- Visual Impairments cost \$35 billion annually
- Hearing Impairments cost \$154 billion annually





ASSISTIVE SERVICES TECHNOLOGIES - DEPRESSION



Depression

- 25% of 60+ population will experience in some form
- Most cases not diagnosed
- Leading Cause of Disability
- New Technologies in Telemental Health and Social Networking







ASSISTIVE SERVICE TECHNOLOGIES – MEDICATION COMPLIANCE



Medication Management

- Prescribing, order communication, and administration
- Medication non-adherence related to 15% of all U.S. hospital visits
- 75% of American consumers don't take medicines as prescribed









ASSISTIVE SERVICES TECHNOLOGIES – CHRONIC ILLNESS



Remote patient monitoring and telehealth systems for:

- Heart Failure
- Diabetes
- Asthma
- COPD
- Hypertension









ASSISTIVE SERVICES TECHNOLOGIES: MOBILITY /ACCESSIBILITY



17% of People over age 65 have some ADL Impairment









ASSISTIVE SERVICE TECHNOLOGIES FUNCTIONAL DECLINE



- Broad term to describe decrease in both physical/cognitive abilities
- Emotional and monetary carer burdens are immense (Estimate \$375 billion in U.S.A. alone)


















WILL "BOOMERS" ACCEPT NEW TECHNOLOGIES?
